MINISTRY OF WELCOME

Baptisms: Please email the office for a booking form and more details. Baptisms take place the 1st and 3rd Sunday of the month directly after 11am Mass and on Thursday evenings at 6pm. At least one month's notice is required, during which parents meet with a member of our Baptismal Team and the family attends the 11am Sunday Mass weekly, prior to the Baptism. Families must also be present at 11am Mass on the morning their child receives the sacrament and be ready to begin immediately after Mass. If families are unable to complete the preparation or attend Mass, the Baptism will be rebooked to a time when they can.

Weddings: Couples must contact Fr Declan six months before the date of their wedding to arrange to complete the necessary paperwork. Couples are also required to attend a pre-marriage course. A Wedding Mass is only offered to those who attend Mass in their parish *weekly* during the six-month notice of marriage period.

Down and Connor Diocesan Pilgrimage to Lourdes We hope that there will be over 300 pilgrims from across the Diocese traveling in July, over 60 young adults and 40 volunteer staff are part of this year's pilgrimage. We are delighted that over 20 pilgrims requiring medical and personal care will stay in the Accueil Notre Dame with our care team. This return to a larger pilgrimage brings with it its own challenge, as it draws more significantly on our pilgrimage fund. Not only do we subsidise the fares of those pilgrims who require significant care and support to travel, we also provide support for the volunteers and significant support to enable the young people to travel, to provide that care and support. Like everyone else we have noticed the increased costs associated with travel and in getting the materials we require while in Lourdes and in administering the pilgrimage. For this reason, we will leave a box out for donations during Masses. You can add your name to the sheet on the table and your names will be brought with us to Lourdes and included in our Masses and prayers each day.

We also leave them at the Grotto with our petitions.
