Thank you to Gerry for removing all the Ivy from the old cross at the side of the church. This cross dates back to the original chapel of Aghagallon in 1748, which was a thatched house and was maliciously consumed by fire immediately after the rebellion of 1798. The chapel at some after period was again roofed and slated and remained so until the new church was built in 1834, it stood on the site where the school is now. The cross from the original chapel was then placed in the vestry of the new chapel, (in the south side wall, stands a neat corniced cut stone bearing the bearing the following inscription: "This chapel was built by Revd Felix O'Donnell, Arthur McHenry and the rest of the parish in the year 1748" Ordnance Survey Memoirs of Ireland).

Under the cross is another plaque, this belonged to the new church built and was also in the vestry. It is corniced stone bearing the following inscription: "Rebuilt AD 1834 by Revd Daniel McGary P.P". You can see this cross at the grass area between the Church and Parochial House.

All of the above information is from the Ordnance Survey Memoirs of Ireland book, Parishes of County Antrim VII 1832-8.

Baptisms: Please email the office for a booking form and more details. Baptisms take place the 1st and 3rd Sunday of the month directly after 11am Mass and on Thursday evenings at 6pm. At least one month's notice is required, during which parents meet with a member of our Baptismal Team and the family attends the 11am Sunday Mass weekly, prior to the Baptism. Families must also be present at 11am Mass on the morning their child receives the sacrament and be ready to begin immediately after Mass. If families are unable to complete the preparation or attend Mass, the Baptism will be rebooked to a time when they can.

Weddings: Couples must contact Fr Declan six months before the date of their wedding to arrange to complete the necessary paperwork. Couples are also required to attend a pre-marriage course. A Wedding Mass is only offered to those who attend Mass in their parish *weekly* during the six-month notice of marriage period.
